Dear Grand-campers,

Greetings from Camp Phillip! We are looking forward to another fun session of Grand Camp this summer. Check-in is on Sunday between 2:30 and 4:30 p.m. When you arrive, stop at the Dining Hall to register and receive any special information, including a detailed schedule. Our health care staff will also review your completed health form.

**Please return the completed health form and balance of tuition to us at least 4 weeks prior to your arrival at camp.**

After you have moved to your campsite, bring yourself and your grandchildren to the Big Toy, our playground, at 4:30 to meet the Grand Camp leaders and the other campers.

Activities during Grand Camp will include Bible stories, outdoor games, swimming, singing, crafts and nature activities. Lunch and a snack will be provided. Campers will be supervised at all times by trained staff and by certified lifeguards at the waterfront. Join your grandchild in the daily activities if you wish, or take a break and enjoy some free time on your own.

The camp day begins at 9:30 a.m. and concludes at 4:30 p.m. Children may be dropped off and picked up at our playground. Although Grandparent/Grandchild Camp runs during the day, you and your grandchildren are welcome to join the rest of Son Shine Camp in our morning devotions and evening sing-along and campfires. You will also have your own "closing program," which you are invited and encouraged to attend, on Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. at the Comfort Station.

- You have not yet contacted us to reserve a campsite. If you will be staying at Camp Phillip during Grand-Camp, please call us to reserve one for you. We have both electrical and non-electrical sites. Limited cabins may be available. We have also listed area hotel options on our website.

If you'd rather not cook at your campsite, we will provide food service for your family while you are at camp. Prices for 6 extra meals for adults are \$38. Children 6-12 years are \$35. Children under 6 years are free. These prices include state sales tax. If possible, notify camp ahead of time to request food service.

If your grandchild is not able to come to camp and you must cancel, please inform us as soon as possible. It could be possible to fill that spot with someone on the waiting list. We will refund your money minus a \$45 processing fee. Refund requests must be made in writing.
